The Arew project has gotten off to a running start. The team purchased the equipment they needed. They'll soon learn how to use the translation-specific software necessary for their work.

Plotting Their Strategy

In coming months, the Arew team will be drafting the Gospels of Mark, Luke and John. This will give them practice in studying and discussing each passage in question and then writing out the translation in their mother tongue. Afterwards, they'll check the translation as a group, starting with Luke.

Translation Step 1: First Draft

Translating the Scriptures in first draft begins with exegesis, which is the explanation or critical interpretation of a Scripture text essential to creating this draft.

- **Continue to pray that the team will cultivate a good work ethic during the early phases of the project.**
- **Keep praying that the translators can maintain the momentum with which they started.**
- **Pray that local churches will continue to be supportive and encouraging to the team.**
- **Pray for protection for the team and their family members. As they encroach on Satan's long-held territory, opposition is to be expected.**
- **Ask God to safeguard the team members' time and unity as well as their health and physical wellbeing.**
